

**Your legacy**

For Iowa Public Radio listeners and community leaders, the bequest is the most popular type of planned gift. A bequest does not reduce your current income, yet enables you to provide substantial future support for the mission of Iowa Public Radio. An estate gift has several advantages:

- Charitable gifts made through your estate are deductible for estate tax purposes.
- You may direct your estate gift to Iowa Public Radio's area of greatest need or to a specific purpose or funding priority.
- When you notify Iowa Public Radio of your bequest intention, you will be invited to join the Iowa Public Radio Heritage Society.

**How to word your bequest**

You may provide for Iowa Public Radio by either making a new Will, modifying your present Will (by adding a codicil), or by including Iowa Public Radio in your revocable trust. Your Will should be drafted by your attorney. You and your estate planner may find the following language helpful:

<b>Specified Amount:</b>	I give and bequeath to Iowa Public Radio, a not-for-profit corporation located in Des Moines, Iowa, the sum of \$_____.
<b>Percentage of Estate:</b>	I give and bequeath to Iowa Public Radio, a not-for-profit corporation located in Des Moines, Iowa, _____ % of my gross estate as determined for estate tax purposes.
<b>Specific Property:</b>	I give and bequeath to Iowa Public Radio, a not-for-profit corporation located in Des Moines, Iowa, the following described real/personal property....
<b>Residual Bequest:</b>	I give and bequeath to Iowa Public Radio, a not-for-profit corporation located in Des Moines, Iowa, all the rest and residue of my Estate.
